

Player Profiles - Candidates for Your 2018 Unit Board

Unit 487, part of District 20 of the American Contract Bridge League (ACBL), serves members who live in Clackamas, Columbia, Multnomah, and Washington counties. Its seven Board members, who serve overlapping three-year terms, promote competitive bridge by sponsoring sectional tournaments and educational programs. Each year, the Unit replaces two or three retiring Board members with new ones. This year, Nancy Jonske and Jan Clemmons are retiring, so you may cast up to two votes, from among the candidates below or write-in(s), when ballots become available at the local clubs. Here is your opportunity to *meet the-candidates*

Carol Juckland: I grew up in Portland. After graduating with a B.S. from Oregon State, I taught elementary school in New Jersey and Florida before returning to this area in 1975. While teaching, and parenting four children with my husband Phil, I served on school boards and youth swim team boards. I was a Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) for 13 years. Today I serve on the Honors College Board at Oregon State where we support an amazing group of bright and ambitious students.







Monte Garrett: I moved to Oregon in 1984 from the Midwest, after attending Iowa State University and completing B.S. and M.S. degrees in wildlife biology. Working in a post-graduate program at Oregon State, I conducted research on bald eagles of the Lower Columbia River. After that, I worked as a wildlife biologist and program manager at PacifiCorp, an electric utility company based in Portland, until retiring in 2014. During my acade mic and professional life, I worked frequently with the public and volunteered with such organizations as Audubon working on bird conservation and management.

Following my retirement, I resumed a passion for bridge that was initiated during my early years in college but was largely absent for more than 45 years. As a Unit 487 board member, I would like to promote this most interesting of all card games, for both its intellectual and social values, to people of all ages.

Nely Johnson: I was born in communist Romania to parents who barely survived WWII: my mother having rescued my father from a labor camp and my father later having brought Russian soldiers liberating our city to the train station where my mother and others were to be transported to a concentration camp.

When I was 14, we immigrated to the U.S. I earned undergraduate and law degrees from the University of Wisconsin and began practice in the early 1970s. In 1974 I moved to Portland, where I practiced primarily public interest law, was elected to District and then



Circuit Court, and served as a trial judge for 24 years. I served as president of the District Court Judges Association and chair of the Judicial Education Committee, and worked as an adjunct law professor at Lewis & Clark.

Before retirement I played occasional party bridge when someone needed a fill-in. A few years ago I discovered duplicate and was hooked.
